Project Summary

Syracuse Research Corporation 6225 Running Ridge Road, Cicero

The Project: The Syracuse Research Corporation is asking the Agency to issue approximately \$18,000,000 in tax-exempt 501-c-3 bonds to finance the construction and equipping of a 120,000 square foot research facility to be located next to the existing facility the Town of Cicero. Total project cost is estimated to be \$18,000,000 and includes \$250,000 for land acquisition, \$14,000,000 for building construction, \$1,530,000 for machinery and equipment, \$1,500,000 for engineering, and \$720,000 in legal and financial charges.

Syracuse Research Corporation was founded in 1957 as a not-for-profit research and development company focusing primarily on engineering, environmental research and information technology. The company has recently secured major contracts with the Department of Defense and Environmental Protection Agency.

<u>Current Facilities</u>: The Company currently occupies a 77,000 square foot office, research and light manufacturing facility. The acquisition of the existing facility was financed in 1997 with Agency-issued bonds in the amount of \$6,325,000.

Employment: The Corporation currently has 390 employees at this location. It will add 125 within one year of completion of the project.

<u>Zoning</u>: The proposed site is zoned Regional Commercial and the proposed use is permitted in the zone.

<u>PILOT Agreement</u>: The Corporation is a not-for–profit corporation and is exempt from real property taxes. Therefore there will be no basis for a PILOT agreement with the Agency.

<u>Environmental Review</u>: The status of the project under SEQRA will be reviewed at the October Agency meeting. The project exceeds 100,000 square feet and appears to be a Type I action under SEQRA, requiring the designation of a lead agency for SEQRA purposes.

<u>Financing</u>: The Agency will issued qualified tax-exempt bonds to finance the project, with credit enhancement provided by the company.

Agency Fee: The Agency fee is .0075 of the bond amount. If the bond amount for the project is \$18,000,000, the Agency fee will be \$135,000.00.
