Tessy Plastics Corp. (the "Applicant"), has requested that the Agency enter into a straight lease transaction for a project consisting of the construction of a 98,000 square foot addition to existing manufacturing facility, located at 488 Route 5 West in the Town of Elbridge (the "Project"). The Project will be initially operated and/or managed by the Applicant.

The Agency contemplates that it will acquire an interest in the Project by accepting title to or leasehold interest in the Project and leasing the Project to the Applicant pursuant to a lease or installment sale agreement.
